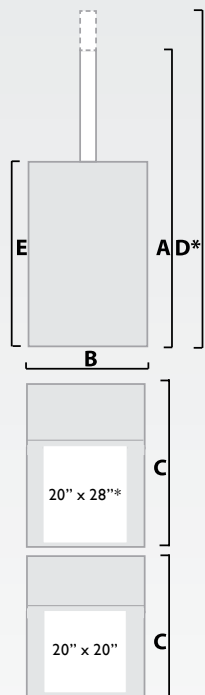

# Combination of Bagging and Baling

Models 5031 and 5031-E are both capable of compacting waste into bags or making small bales of cardboard, paper sacks, plastic film, etc. The difference between them is strictly the size of the drum. As bagging compactors, both models work the same way as our model 5030 where the bag is placed on the outside of the bottom-less drum to prevent torn bags.

Available with dust exhaust collar.



## Bale and/or bag

The 5031 produces bales or bags weighing up to 110 lbs (5031) or 145 lbs (5031-E). Press force is 6,600 lbs, operating cycle time approx. 30 seconds. Special models of the 5031 are also available for dusty environments.

- finished bale can be tied and/or ejected into a bag
- perfect for 50-100lb. dusty sacks
